Measure	Licensing Terms Guidelines
<b>Overview</b>	New guidelines will be published to communicate the terms that will be added to the licence of any trainer coming off a suspension for a violation of the positive test and/or medication rules. This measure will provide the Ontario Racing Commission (ORC) with access to his/her stable, regardless of location, and the ability to conduct out-of-competition testing when needed.
<b>Effective Date</b>	Issuance of Policy Directive on Guidelines January 31, 2008.
<b>Background</b>	<p>While the ability of the Executive Director to add terms and conditions to a licence is a normal and accepted practice, there is a need to make the community more aware of the types of terms that will be added to a licence for particular types of cases.</p> <p>A Policy Directive will be used to communicate the terms that will be added to the licence of a trainer upon completion of a suspension for a positive test/drug violation.</p> <p>These terms would confirm the ability of the ORC to perform out of competition testing, and conduct inspections of the trainer's facility to look for illegal or non-therapeutic medications/drugs and to seize such items.</p>
<b>Rules</b>	No rule change required. Issuance of Policy Directive.
